

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at ACY grew by 2.6 percent. Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, grew 5.7 percent as it carried 6,194 additional passengers. Spirit's seat capacity, however, was up only 1,990 seats (+1.6%). While Fort Lauderdale, Fort Myers, Tampa, and West Palm Beach benefitted from the combined addition of 15,532 seats, Boston, Orlando and Myrtle Beach saw a joint reduction of 13,542 seats. International traffic, which is mostly charter, posted its fourth consecutive monthly drop as it fell 100 percent. Domestic charter activity also fell - down 37 percent.
