

Aviation Department

August passenger traffic performance was disappointing as activity fell 8.2%. Overall seat capacity was down 5.7%. Except for Myrtle Beach, all of Spirit's services to Florida destinations weakened, and Spirit carried 5,598 fewer passengers. Domestic charter activity fell 158%. As result, YTD August traffic is down 1.4% and year-end traffic is likely to turn negative versus 2014.
