The airport handled 3.5 million passengers as traffic gained 3.5%, pushing YTD August traffic up 4.2%. Continuing a trend established earlier this year, EWR's traffic growth was dominated by the domestic sector, which gained 4.3% following a 4.5% seat capacity increase. United led the seat capacity expansion and accounted for 74% of the incremental domestic passenger gain. Delta and American increased capacity by 8% each. With an August gain of 2%, the international sector reversed four consecutive months of decline as seat capacity improved 2%, led by United, Delta and La Compagnie. August traffic also benefited from a spike in international charter activity. Freight at EWR continues to lead the region's cargo growth, gaining 1.4% in August and lifting YTD August cargo growth to 6.8%.
