Similar to JFK, the airport set a record as it handled 3.4 million passengers in the month of April. EWR's 5.5 percent traffic growth - the highest rate among our airports in April - was led by the domestic sector, which grew 7.9 percent. Airlines increased domestic capacity by 143,270 seats, for a 5.5 percent improvement. In contrast to the trend established in the last three months, international traffic growth slowed significantly, as it gained only 0.1 percent. This weakness was consistent with the 2.4 percent seat capacity decline in April. Led by a 6 percent increase in domestic cargo, freight activity at EWR grew 5.2 percent. Meanwhile, international cargo, which constitutes nearly 40 percent of the airport's total, bounced back following a 7.6 percent fall in March and grew 3.7 percent.
