For the fifth consecutive month, Newark led our region's airports with an 8.5 percent gain while handling a record 3.6 million passengers, or an additional 280,354 passengers. Continuing with a trend that began in March, the domestic sector led EWR's strong growth with an 11.6 percent increase. EWR led the region's three major airports in domestic seat capacity with a 4.3 percent expansion, or 111,984 additional seats. EWR also set a record of 1.1 million international passengers - a 2.2 percent increase. Airlines grew international seat capacity by 2.5 percent - 32,498 extra seats. Cargo traffic at EWR grew a strong 15.9 percent. The domestic sector, which accounts for over 60 percent of the airport's cargo activity, led the expansion with a 25.6 percent surge. International cargo inched up 0.3 percent.
