

Newark handled a record 3.5 million passengers and led our region's airports with a 7.8 percent increase, or an additional 250,546 passengers. This increase represented almost half of the region's total passenger gain. The domestic sector, which has been EWR's leader in passenger growth since February, led growth with a 10 percent increase. EWR led the region in domestic seat capacity growth with a solid 7 percent gain, or 181,398 additional seats. International passenger traffic and seats both grew 3 percent. EWR bucked the negative freight performance among our region's airports in May as it registered a 5.2 percent rise. International cargo, which constitutes approximately 40 percent of the airport's total cargo activity, led the improvement with an 11.7 percent gain. Domestic cargo increased 1.5 percent.
