

Aviation Department

The 8.7% passenger traffic growth at JFK in February was largely attributable to domestic travel as it jumped 12.8%. This remarkable growth was better than expected because the weather in February 2015 was milder compared to February 2014. Domestic flights increased 7.8%, which suggests that the airport had comparably fewer cancellations. Delta and JetBlue combined accounted for 93% of domestic incremental passengers. International travel was up 4.7%. JetBlue, Etihad, Norwegian, British, and Caribbean Air combined carried 83,500 more passengers. The JFK cargo sector increased 4.5%, with domestic up 4.4% and international growing 4.5%.
