

Aviation Department

Following the same patterns at other airports, domestic travel at LGA, which makes up approximately 93% of airport's traffic, grew 9.2% following a 5.2% seat capacity expansion, suggesting that planes were fuller. Domestic flights were up 5.7%. Delta, US Airways, Southwest, JetBlue, Virgin America, United, and Frontier combined carried 160,000 more passengers. International travel increased 1.1% even though the seat capacity was down a sharp 11% primarily due to Delta's flight attrition to Bermuda and Nassau, and American's capacity reductions in excess of 20% to Toronto. International passenger travel was lifted solely due to Air Canada and WestJet's performance, which grew in excess of 7%.
