Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic continued growing in February, posting a hefty 8.8% increase. This unusually strong number came as no surprise because our weather in February 2014 was far more severe, causing thousands of flight cancellations last year, primarily in domestic markets. Consequently, domestic travel this year contributed the most to the increase, rising 10.6%. International passenger levels were up 5.3%. Another reason for the traffic increase was a 3.6% seat capacity expansion by carriers serving our region. However, the capacity growth disproportionately originated from two of our facilities: JFK and LGA. Developments in cargo markets resemble the regional passenger trends as the tonnage increased 6.8% in February.
