

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at SWF bounced back modestly - up 0.2 percent - following 14 consecutive months of negative performance. Growth was led by a 6.3 percent increase by USAir/AA and Delta. USAir/AA achieved a 6.3 percent increase, in spite of a 15.6 percent cut in seat capacity to Philadelphia. Delta registered a 1.6 percent growth even though it cut its seat capacity to Detroit by 3.4 percent. Overall, airlines cut seat capacity by 4.5 percent. The combination of slightly higher passenger traffic and reduced seat capacity resulted in higher aircraft load factors. Stewart's cargo movement recorded its third consecutive monthly gain - up 5.8 percent. The main driver of this improvement was FedEx.
