

Aviation Department

By growing 2.7 percent and carrying 4.7 million passengers in April, JFK continued the torrid pace it set in the first three months of the year. Buoyed by a 6.2 percent increase in seat capacity, the international sector continued to lead growth with a gain of 4.3 percent. In contrast to trends in the first three months and despite a 2.3 percent seat gain, domestic passenger traffic fell 0.3 percent in April. Two elements were responsible for the domestic passenger decline. First, 95,354 passengers were lost due to service cessation by United, and AA/US Airways carried 49,156 fewer passengers. More importantly, Delta and JetBlue's growth slowed from the previous scorching pace. JFK's cargo activity fell 4.1 percent in April. International cargo led the contraction with a 4.4 percent fall. The domestic sector fell by 2.6 percent.
