

Passenger traffic reached a record level of 5.1 million passengers and grew 3 percent, buoyed by a 4.8 percent gain in seat capacity. The international sector led the growth with a 5.8 percent increase (150,548 added passengers). Led by Delta and JetBlue, JFK's international seat capacity expanded by 6.9 percent - the highest among our airports. On the other hand, the domestic sector edged down modestly by 0.1 percent, or 2,225 fewer passengers, in spite of a 2 percent gain in seat capacity. This slightly negative performance was mainly due to United and US Airways, which ceased their operations at JFK. In May of 2015, these two airlines carried 99,113 and 56,996 passengers respectively. Cargo movement through JFK fell 6.1 percent as both international and domestic cargo activity contracted at the same pace.
