

Aviation Department

EWR served 3.5 million passengers in July, growing 3.1 percent. For the year, the airport is up a solid 4.3 percent. Continuing a trend established earlier this year, EWR's traffic growth was concentrated exclusively in the domestic sector, which gained 7.6 percent following a 4.6 percent seat capacity increase. The international sector posted its fifth consecutive monthly decline, falling 4.8 percent. Freight at EWR continues to lead the region's cargo growth, gaining 3.8 percent in July and lifting YTD cargo growth to 7.6 percent. Domestic cargo, led the growth with a gain of 9.9% but international was down 5.4%.
