

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic grew 7.8 percent at JFK. Domestic and international segments grew at comparable rates, gaining 7.9 percent and 7.7 percent respectively. With YTD July growth hovering around 6.7 percent, JFK is headed for another record-breaking year in both the domestic and international markets. Down 1.9 percent in July, JFK's cargo weakness was primarily responsible for the region's flat performance. Domestic tonnage, which had been weak since the middle of last year, continued its downward trajectory as it fell 2.2 percent and international cargo was down 1.9%.
