

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at SWF continued to decrease and was down 4.4 percent. JetBlue's traffic, which accounts for about 42 percent of SWF's total, was down 2.6 percent even though its capacity was unchanged. This is the fifth consecutive month of passenger attrition for JetBlue. In contrast to JetBlue, passenger traffic for Delta's service to Detroit and Allegiant's service to Tampa grew 5.4 percent and 10 percent respectively. But these gains were not enough to overcome JetBlue's decrease, along with a 21 percent decline in US Airways' passenger traffic to PHL.
