

Aviation Department

With March passenger traffic up 2.8%, YTD March passenger traffic grew gained 3.1%. LGA's domestic sector led the airport's growth with a gain of 3.7%, led mostly by low-cost carriers. Southwest, Jetblue and Virgin America collectively carried 184,000. Delta also played a significant role as it generated a net increase of 117,000 passengers. First quarter international passenger traffic was down 4.9%, due in part to an 11 decline in seat capacity, principally from Delta's service reductions to the Bahamas and Nassau.
