

Aviation Department

EWR served 3.1 million passengers in May growing 5.7%. Similar to the April traffic pattern, growth originated mostly from the domestic markets as it jumped 8.9% following 10.4% seat capacity increase. United led the seat capacity expansion and accounted for 80% of the incremental domestic passenger gain. The top five domestic destinations were Atlanta, Dallas, Hartford, West Palm Beach and New Orleans. International travel established a downward pattern as it posted the 3rd consecutive monthly decrease albeit the monthly rate of decline has not exceeded one percent yet. The 0.6% decrease in May was due to seat capacity attrition to Western European, Canadian and Caribbean destinations. Freight grew 5.8% at EWR with domestic growing 10.8% and international decreasing 2%.
