

Aviation Department

Traffic grew 6.2% with domestic and international traffic up 8.1% and 4.5% respectively. Carriers boosted domestic capacity by 6.7% with Delta, JetBlue, American and Sun Country combined carrying 208,800 more passengers mainly to San Francisco, Seattle, LA Fort Lauderdale, West Palm Beach, Long Beach, Miami, Boston and Chicago. Carriers expanded international seat capacity by 5.6%. Delta, Emirates, Norwegian, China Southern and XL Airways combined carried 190,300 more passengers. Top international destinations with incremental seat capacity exceeding 15,000 were Dubai, Paris, Taipei, London and Zurich. Cargo was down 1.1%. Domestic tonnage decreased 5.5% as AA continued to pull the tonnage down due to fleet change and decreased activity, which started in mid-2014. International cargo was down 0.2%.
