## **Regional Satellite Airport Summaries**

Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

## Aviation Department

Following the best April ever, passenger traffic expanded 5.1% in May in our region making it the best May ever yet again. Our airports served 10.7 million passengers or half a million more compared to May of last year. YTD growth is up 5.2% which translates to 2.4 million incremental passengers compared to similar period last year. Following established pattern, domestic traffic contributed the most, rising 6.3%. International travel was up 3.1%. Region's traffic growth benefited from 4.1% seat capacity expansion and relatively fuller planes. Cargo performance was up 1%. While, international cargo was down a modest 0.5%, domestic cargo, which has been fueling the growth since the beginning of the year was up 4.2% and posted its 6th consecutive increase.
