

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at SWF was down 10.1% following 5.9% seat capacity reduction. JetBlue's traffic was down 4.4% even though the capacity was kept unchanged. This is the third consecutive month of passenger attrition for JetBlue. Similar to JetBlue, Delta and US Airways experienced passenger traffic attrition as well. The only carrier which continued to grow was Allegiant. US Airways scheduled further capacity reductions. Hence, we might see continuing passenger traffic decline throughout the year. Stewart's cargo was down 11% due to decreased activity of UPS and FedEx.
