

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic performance at ACY experienced its seventh consecutive monthly decline, falling 1.9 percent. Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, was nearly flat as it carried 220 fewer passengers and its seat capacity, too, was relatively unchanged, up 0.20 percent. Seat capacity fell 5 percent, translating to 5,770 fewer seats, due to the 6,000-seat reduction resulting from United Airlines leaving the market. The overall decline was less severe than in October because of a 5.4 percent increase in domestic charter activity. December 2015 traffic performance could reflect growth because United Airlines' departure in December 2014 finally comes off the year-over-year books.
