JFK led the region's growth in November. Passenger traffic rose 9.7 percent, led by a 10.7 percent increase in the international sector. Delta and JetBlue were the top contributors of JFK's international passenger increase, accounting for a combined 77,109 additional passengers. The domestic sector grew 8.6 percent. Delta and JetBlue continued to be the top contributors of JFK's domestic passenger gain. Carriers expanded domestic capacity by 2.8 percent, led by Delta and JetBlue. Airlines expanded international seat capacity by 6.6 percent - a total of 186,582 additional seats. Delta, JetBlue, and Virgin Atlantic carried a combined total of 92,461 additional passengers and added 30,842 seats. JFK's cargo traffic fell 2.4 percent in November. The domestic sector led the fall with a 7.7 percent plunge.
