The region's passenger traffic enjoyed its highest growth rate of 2015 in November as it expanded by 9 percent. Our airports served a record 9.9 million passengers, or 819,000 more than we handled in November 2014. This gain translates to a year-to-date growth of 6.1 percent, or 6.5 million additional passengers over the same period last year. As in the previous two months, domestic traffic set the pace with a 10.1 percent increase, while international traffic was up 6.9 percent. The region's traffic growth benefitted from a 2.9 percent seat capacity expansion. The region is on track to set another passenger traffic record in 2015, with a year-over-year growth rate above 5 percent. Following a modest increase in October, the region's cargo performance landed in negative territory for the third time in 2015, falling 1.1 percent. Both domestic and international cargo fell 1.1 percent.
