SWF's traffic performance continues to deteriorate. Sept. traffic was down 5.8%. YTD Sept. passenger and seat capacity fell 8.6 percent and 8.3 percent respectively, and the airport carried 2,000 fewer passengers. SWF traffic is unlikely to improve in the 4th Qtr because, seat capacity (Oct-Dec) is scheduled to decline 14.6%.
