

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Following a modest increase of 0.2 percent in January, total passenger traffic at SWF fell by 1.4 percent. The decline was led by a 13.4 percent decrease by Delta. JetBlue saw a 3.2 percent fall in passenger traffic, in spite of increasing its seats to Fort Lauderdale and Orlando by 3.6 percent each. Airlines cut seat capacity by 2.2 percent. Delta led the reduction in seat capacity with a 9.3 percent cut to Detroit. Stewart's cargo movement recorded its fourth consecutive monthly increase, up 10 percent. As in the month of January, the main driver of this improvement was FedEx, which transported 160 additional tons for a 25.7 percent increase.
