

Aviation Department

SWF's total passenger traffic fell by 582 passengers, down 2.2 percent. The decline was led by a combined drop of 3,711 passengers by Delta and American/US Airways. Allegiant Air carried an extra 3,140 passengers - for a whopping 113.7 percent increase, which partly covered the deficit caused by Delta and American /US Airways. Airlines cut seat capacity by 2.7 percent. As in previous months, Delta led the reductions in seats by slashing its seats to Detroit by 31.3 percent. Meanwhile, American/US Airways cut its seats to Philadelphia by 17.7 percent. Led by a 16.6 percent (212 tons) rise in domestic cargo, total freight activity at Stewart grew a strong 15 percent, up 194 tons. International cargo fell 100 percent - down 18 tons.
