

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at SWF bounced back from its 1.4 percent fall recorded in February. The 1.9 percent improvement was led by American/US Airways, which carried 732 additional passengers. JetBlue saw a 3.6 percent fall in passenger traffic, with no change in its seats capacity. Airlines cut seats by 1.2 percent. American/US Airways led the reduction in seat capacity with a 7.8 percent cut to Philadelphia. Stewart's cargo movement continued to increase, up 9.2 percent and was led by the domestic sector as international cargo fell 100 percent. As in previous months, the main driver of this improvement was FedEx, which transported 204 additional tons for a 36.6 percent increase.
