

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Newark continues to show strong passenger performance as it led our region's airports with a solid 7.3 percent gain and handled a record 3.8 million passengers – up 256,832 travelers. The domestic sector led EWR's strong passenger growth with an 8.7 percent increase. Domestic seats grew by 9.3 percent, or 249,000 added seats. International passenger traffic expanded by 4.5 percent – up 54,008 passengers. Meanwhile, international seat capacity grew 4.6 percent – up 63,502 seats. EWR posted a 14.2 percent increase in total freight activity. EWR was responsible for a significant portion (86 percent) of the region's total cargo gain. Growth was led by the domestic sector, which grew by 17.5 percent (6,041 tons). International cargo, too, showed a strong gain – up 8.3 percent for 1,630 additional tons.
