LGA overcame weather-related struggles in the beginning of the year to finish 5.4 % higher, breaking multiple records. It handled 28.4 million passengers, the most ever, eclipsing the 2014 record total by 1.5 million passengers. Among its other 2015 highlights, LaGuardia broke the previous domestic passenger record of 25.2 million, also set last year, by handling 26.7 million passengers. The domestic record was supported by 6.1 % passenger growth and a 2.3 % increase in seat capacity. Unlike last year, when low-cost carriers led growth, this year's record gain was led by Delta, Southwest and a combined AA/US. International traffic fell 3.4 %. Though Air Canada and West Jet generated a net gain of 120,000 passengers, it was insufficient to overcome capacity cuts by Delta and AA. Combined, Delta and AA carried 181,000 fewer passengers.
