

# World Trade Center Transportation Hub Will Offer Free Wi-Fi

Visitors and commuters will be able to access free Internet at the PATH station and in the retail areas in the WTC transportation hub when it opens next year, officials said.

World Trade Center visitors will get free Wi-Fi service when the site's transportation hub opens next year, officials said Monday.

The Port Authority struck a deal with Boingo Wireless to launch the network, which patrons will be able to use at the PATH station and in the retail areas in the WTC transportation hub.

More than 200,000 people a day are expected to pass through the hub when it's completed.

Users will be able to log on to the free Internet for as long as they want, and will not be limited to 30 minutes online like at the Port Authority's airports, a spokeswoman said.
