

Symbol of Resilience: World Trade Center Spire is Hoisted 104-Stories to Crown New York's Tallest Building in Emotional Display

The first section of the steel spire set to crown One World Trade Center as the third tallest building in the world has been hoisted 1,776 feet to its top today. Described as a symbol of resilience from the construction workers and people watching below, nine of the 18 pieces were lifted up 104-stories in New York's lower Manhattan on Wednesday in a moving 45-minute display. 'It means a lot to all of us. It really shows the resilience of the region and even the world,' Steven Plate, WTC's director of construction told CBS. 'This is part of history in the making.'
