

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at ACY grew by 4.3 percent - the highest growth rate of 2016. Growth was totally driven by a 5.3 percent increase in domestic traffic, as the international sector experienced an 84.2 percent collapse. Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, grew 13.9 percent as it carried 11,708 extra passengers. Domestic charter activity continued to struggle - down 55.4 percent - or 6,581 fewer passengers. International traffic posted its sixth consecutive monthly drop - down 84.2 percent - or 928 less passengers. The main factor behind this decline was Air Canada's cessation of operations at ACY. In June of 2015, Air Canada carried 1,102 travelers.
