

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at ACY edged up 1.1 percent. Though Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, grew 7.5 percent as it carried 6,918 extra passengers, domestic charter activity fell by a whopping 46.9 percent, or 5,359 fewer passengers, and thus caused total traffic to inch up modestly. International traffic posted its fifth consecutive monthly drop as it fell 100 percent, off by 425 passengers. Two elements contributed to this decline. There was a 100 percent fall in international charter - down 197 passengers - and Air Canada ended its operations at ACY. In May of last year, Air Canada carried 228 travelers.
