

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell 3.6%, a significant improvement over the 12% average decline in the first three months and similar to the 4.0% reduction in scheduled seats. Domestic traffic was down 5.6% on a 4.9% drop in seats. For the first time this year, international growth catapulted into positive territory with a 1.0% increase. The gain was primarily attributable to Continental, which carried 10-11% more passengers to Mexico, Central and South America and Puerto Rico.
