

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic decline 2.7%. Domestic traffic fell 5.0% while international was flat compared to April 2008. The pace of decline in freight worsened since March, falling 36.4% year over year in both domestic and international markets. Freighter flight activity was down 34.9%.
