

Aviation Department

SWF was the only facility to experience a decline in passenger traffic in April with a 1.5% fall. Contributing factors include a 11% or 590 seat decline by US Airways to Philadelphia. More importantly, Jetblue, the number one ranking carrier at the airport downgraded its fleet by switching from 158-seat A320 to smaller 100-seat regional jet to serve Fort Lauderdale. This led to a decline of 33% or 1,500 fewer seats on this route. SWF's cargo which makes up less than 1 percent of the region's cargo was up 8.4%.
