Aviation Department
 April traffic was down 2.5% with domestic declining 2.5% and international down 2.7%. As a result of Easter holiday appearing in March this year as oppose to April last year, UA/CO, Delta, American and JetBlue collectively carried 94,000 fewer passengers on their domestic routes. UA/CO, the dominant carrier at EWR with almost 70% of airport's traffic share, reduced seat capacity to its Florida destinations by 22%. Consequently, YTD domestic traffic slowed to 0.4% growth. UA/CO also cut seat capacity on its international routes by 37,500 seats with Caribbean/Bermuda destinations bearing the sharpest reductions. This, along with consolidation of services away from EWR to JFK by Alitalia and Lot Polish resulted in YTD international passenger's 1.2% drop. Cargo continued to fall as YTD April was down 7.5%.
