

Aviation Department

ACY continued its double-digit growth in April with passenger traffic up 23.6%. With the arrival of United's services to Houston and Chicago, the airport is nicely positioned for further growth. The airport's seat capacity growth for April was a remarkable 40%. Spirit Airlines served seven destinations in April and experienced a double-digit capacity increase of 32%, with an actual passenger increase of 24.5%. Six of Spirit's seven destinations serve Florida, and the biggest beneficiaries were Fort Lauderdale and Fort Myers. With its seasonal flight to Boston commencing in April, Spirit will continue to grow, pushing ACY's traffic numbers even higher.
