Although international traffic edged up 4.5% at EWR this month, the 3.1% decline in domestic travel pulled overall traffic down to 0.7% because domestic makes up two-thirds of all traffic at the airport. United, the airport's dominant carrier, was the only domestic airline that carried fewer passengers, as its traffic fell 9.4%. The strong performance in international traffic was possible because of a 5.7% increase in transatlantic travel, which is the leading international market at EWR. Traffic to the Caribbean followed with a 5.5% increase. Transpacific passenger traffic jumped 16.2% because of Cathay Pacific's outstanding performance. Cargo tonnage fell 0.9%, the smallest level of decline since January 2013. International cargo, which makes up close to 40% of the airport's total tonnage, increased 3.2%.
