

Aviation Department

ACY's passenger traffic increased 0.7% following a 1.7% seat capacity attrition. Even though Spirit Airlines, the only regular airline at the airport, increased its seats by 3.4% and carried 4.1% more passengers, overall growth slowed due to service cessation by United. Air Canada's new scheduled seasonal service to Toronto may help boost numbers, but will not completely replace United's passenger volumes.
