

**Aviation Department**

Passenger traffic at SWF continued to decline and was down 9.9% following a 5.5% seat capacity reduction because of US Airways' 30% seat capacity reduction to Philadelphia. JetBlue, Allegiant, and Delta plan to keep their seats stable. However, US Airways is set to continue the capacity attrition for the rest of the year. Thus, we might see further passenger traffic decline throughout the year. Cargo was down 10.8% due to decreased activity of UPS and FedEx.
