

## Aviation Department

Traffic fell (9.0%) year-over-year on a (3.7%) seat loss. The biggest service cuts were at Tampa, which lost 53% in seat capacity, Bermuda where Delta dropped all service, and New Orleans, which lost 47% of its seats. Montreal, which had no service last year, is now served by American with 148 daily nonstop seats.
