

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic fell 3.6 percent on 4.1 percent more scheduled seats. The decline was divided between respective domestic and international declines of 5.2 percent and 2.1 percent. Domestic seats grew 6.1 percent, outpacing 2.3 percent growth for international seats. American again led the pack of U.S. flag airlines at Kennedy, with 2.3 percent growth, on a scheduled seat capacity gain of 12.6 percent. JFK freight decreased 5.8 percent, with a 4.6 percent domestic gain and an 8 percent international decline. Freighter operations declined 2.4 percent.
