

Aviation Department

Stewart was the only airport to show growth in our airport system. Passenger traffic grew 11.7 percent in August aided by the added seasonal overlay to Orlando. Stewart's cargo operations grew by 44.4 percent, benefiting from an earlier increase in service by FedEx, whose freight volume jumped by 55.5 percent, with UPS up 18.6 percent.
