

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

August passenger traffic increased 1.8%. For the first time since March, both domestic and international traffic grew. This should portend stronger results for future traffic. YTD overall traffic increased 0.4%. Domestic traffic was up 2.3% on a 1.1% seat capacity increase. YTD domestic is up slightly at 0.7%. In contrast to domestic capacity growth, international capacity was down 3.3% but traffic was up 0.8%. Compared to last year's August traffic, United, Virgin America, US Airways, JetBlue and Southwest collectively carried 60,500 more passengers on their domestic routes. Delta, SAS, Jet Airways, Air India and Lufthansa collectively served 35,000 more passengers on their international routes.
