Although YTD passenger traffic is up 4.4%, this August marks the first time in the last 21 months that LGA's traffic contracted. Domestic passenger traffic, which accounts for almost 95% of airport's traffic, decreased 1.5% on a 2.2% seat capacity decline. Delta decreased domestic seat capacity by 1.5% and as a result carried 29,000 fewer passengers. The airline decreased seat capacity to Atlanta, Cincinnati, Fort Myers, Fort Lauderdale, Buffalo, Memphis, Boston and Jacksonville. American carried 18,000 fewer passengers due to a 1.6% seat capacity reduction. Although Frontier Airlines has been aggressively cutting capacity since late 2012, it accounted for a quarter of the passenger decrease, carrying 15,700 fewer passengers. With a gain of 10.3%, international traffic established a new monthly record as passenger levels reached 191,000 and helped push traffic into record territory.
