

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell 14.6% in August at SWF. US Airways reported double-digit increase to its Philadelphia destination for the second month in a row, carrying 1,471 more passengers. However, Delta carried 6,770 fewer passengers because of termination of its service to Atlanta and capacity reduction to Detroit. JetBlue, the airport's top-ranked carrier, experienced a slight reduction of 1.1% in passenger traffic. By late fall of this year, we expect the volume of monthly declines to stabilize around 4 to 6 percent as year-over-year data is projected to catch up to 2012 reductions in service by Delta, and Allegiant, a low-cost carrier, begins service.
