

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Passenger traffic increased 2.8% at EWR. Domestic travel was up 1.3%, but the bulk of the airport's traffic jump was driven by international travel, which expanded by 5.7% and pushed YTD up 1%. Cathay Pacific, Austrian Airlines, British, JetBlue, Taca and Iceland Air together carried 58,400 more passengers. Domestically, American, JetBlue, Virgin America, Vision Air and Southwest combined carried 47,900 more passengers. Even though domestic travel grew, the traffic was subdued because US Airways, United and Delta together cancelled out the gains by serving 18,800 fewer passengers. With the runway closure behind us, we anticipate more domestic growth from United. With 2.9% cargo growth in August, EWR scored a second consecutive month with an increase.
