

Aviation Department

Traffic declined (2.9%) on (4.5%) fewer seats. This represents a 4.5 percentage point gain over November. Domestic traffic fell (2.5%) on a (7.4%) seat drop, while international traffic fell (3.3%) on (1.0%) fewer seats. Part of the December improvement is attributable to the late Thanksgiving, pushing some returning passengers into December. Freight fell (28.6%) with international leading the decline with a (30.1%) loss to a domestic (22.8%) loss.
