

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2011 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

SWF served 413,654 passengers in 2011, for a growth of 4.7 percent. Though the level is a long way down from the peak of 914,000 in 2007, growth is growth and builds strongly on the 1.3 percent growth rate attained in 2010. Seat capacity at the airport rose 9.9 percent. This was led by Delta, which increased its seat capacity by 25 percent, mostly to Atlanta, and added a net of 25,302 passengers, for a gain of 21 percent. With expanded services to Orlando, JetBlue's traffic improved 1.1 percent on 6.3 percent seat gain. Stewart's cargo grew nearly 26 percent in 2011 due primarily to expanded FedEx activity.
